

HOW TO REACH ALGHERO

Alghero can be easily reached by plane or by ferry.

1) BY PLANE

Alghero-Fertilia Airport "Riviera del Corallo" is about 10 km from the town centre.

It is connected to several national and international airports.

a) Connections from Alghero Airport to Alghero city centre

By bus

Tickets: ARST Ticket vending machine (Arrivals Lounge – next to the bar/newsagent's)

Single ride ticket: EUR 1

Bus route and stops: departure: Airport – S.P.44 – Tangenziale Ponte Càlic – Fertilia Piazza Venezia Giulia – Viale Burruni, S.S. 127bis – Ponte Càlic – Via Don Minzoni – Via Garibaldi – Porta Terra – Via Vittorio Emanuele – Via Cagliari n.2 (Bar 'Casa del Caffè')

First run/Times: 05:20 a.m. / Buses run every hour starting from 06.30 until 22:30.

By taxi

Taxis are available at the airport from the first flight in the morning to the last flight at night.

The taxi stand is located just outside the Arrivals Lounge.

Taxi fare from the airport: about EUR 20.

It takes about 15 minutes.

2) BY FERRY

The closest passenger port to Alghero is in Porto Torres (approx. 40 km away).

The port of Porto Torres is connected to Barcelona, Genoa, Civitavecchia, Marseille (France), Propriano and Ajaccio (Corse).

Some routes are only seasonal.
